

Important Information about Prior Authorization and Concurrent Review for ECT and IOP for Harvard Pilgrim Health Care

Beginning 9/1/2022, HPHC will no longer require prior authorization or concurrent review for Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT) and Intensive Outpatient (IOP) services for only commercial lines of business, regardless of funding type.

Note: These terms apply to in-network (INN) coverage. For Out-of-Network (OON), please check member benefits. Prior Authorization may be required if the member does not have OON benefits and/or if an accommodation is being requested.

The chart below calls out the codes that no longer require prior authorization and concurrent review.

ECT	IOP
No prior authorization, no notification, and no concurrent review for commercial lines of business: • 90870 - Electroconvulsive therapy (includes necessary monitoring) • Rev 901 – Electroshock treatment	No prior authorization, no notification, and no concurrent review for commercial lines of business: • H0015 - Alcohol and/or drug services; intensive outpatient (treatment program that operates at least 3 hours/day and at least 3 days/week and is based on an individualized treatment plan), including assessment, counseling; crisis intervention, and activity therapies or education • Rev 905 - Intensive Outpatient Services – Psychiatric • Rev 906 - Intensive Outpatient Services – Chemical • S9480 – IOP Psychiatric services per diem
